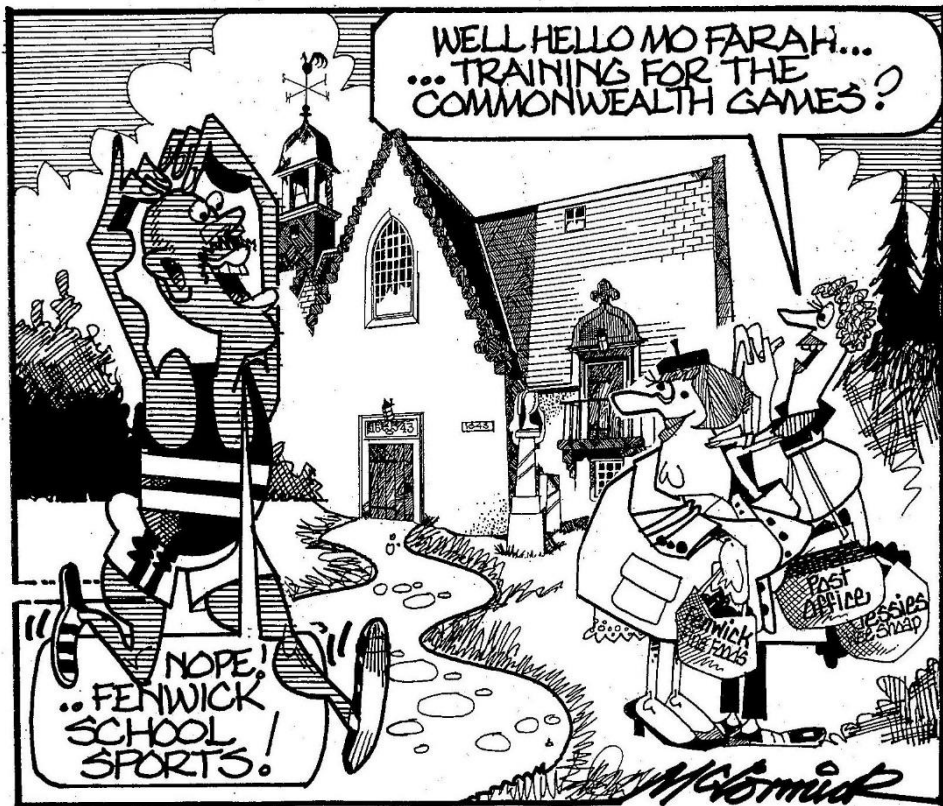

## **The donut of death!**

Did you attempt to buy tickets for the Commonwealth Games recently? Many many people did and the system simply could not handle the volume of people desperately attempting to purchase tickets online.

If you did attempt to navigate to the ticketing site you will have met the “donut of death”. The donut was quite simply a circle designed to wind down until there was no circle left thus providing a graphic illustration of your place in the queue. The text underneath would indicate if you had a wait of 60+ minutes, 30-60 minutes or less than 30 minutes. The graphic wound down very slowly and I don’t think I can remember seeing a wait time of less than 60+ minutes! Hence the euphemism “donut of death”. The graphic was supposed to give hope that your turn was coming instead it simply adding to the growing sense of despair.

I beat the “donut of death” my waking up at 4.30am to find my computer screen flashing a nice shiny login screen at me. A couple of keystrokes later I was in the system desperately trying to decide what to buy tickets for! But tickets I got and I am going to the games. Some folk though waited an eternity and are probably still waiting to get past the “donut of death”!

Imagine if heaven was like that!

A popular image of heaven is of Peter sitting at the pearly gates holding the “Book of Life” in his hands. Before him stands a queue of people waiting to see if their name is written in the “Book of Life”. If it is there they are in if it’s not then it is a shortcut to that other less desirable eternal residence. Now given the population of the earth is fairly large and that death for each of us is a certainty (at some point each of us will leave this life) then the queue before Peter must get fairly long. Perhaps a bigger queue than the number of people trying to log on to select Commonwealth Games tickets? What if we had to wait for all eternity to even gain entry into heaven let alone an eternity in heaven? It would be as if there was a “donut of death” hanging over the gates of heaven.

Thankfully Peter sitting at the Gates of Heaven checking folks names is a piece of fanciful thinking. It has its roots in a couple of piece of scripture but there is more than a wee bit of embellishment to get to Peter, a set of pearly gates and a big book of names.

I have to say I prefer sound theological reasoning even if the image of Peter is well ingrained in our minds.

When it comes to death there are very few folk who hold out to the “we are just dust” line of thinking. We were nothing when we came into the world and we are nothing when we leave it goes that line of thought. Most folk like to think of some form of afterlife, a spiritual existence in another place or the like. We also like to think of our deceased relatives in the same light and hold on the thought that we will meet them again some day.

“How do you get there?” is the question that is rarely asked. What qualifies you for an eternal life in heaven?

The Christian view is this. Those who believe in Jesus as the Son of God and that he died to save them for their sins are the ones who qualify for an eternal existence in the presence of God. “This is how much God loved the world: He gave his Son, his one and only Son. And this is why: so that no one need be destroyed; by believing in him, anyone can have a whole and lasting life. God didn’t go to all the trouble of sending his Son merely to point an accusing finger, telling the world how bad it was. He came to help, to put the world right again. Anyone who trusts in him is acquitted;” (John 3:16 *The Message*). There are other scripture that point in the same direction. I have yet to read a passage that says at which point between life and death we have to make that decision. I would recommend making a conscious decision sooner rather than later! Apart from eternal life such a decision gives you Christ’s life in you now in this life.

There may be other ways. Some think you just have to lead a good life, but what is good? And how good is good enough for God? Others that you follow a set of rules, a code of conduct perhaps? But what if you break one of those rules whatever they may be? Is that it curtains for all eternity? I only know of one sure and certain way to beat the “donut of death” at the gates of heaven and to be presented with a nice shiny login screen. That way is simply to put your trust in Jesus now. Here in this life not at its waning or ending. Now this moment. Don’t take my word for it explore it for yourself, ask the questions find the answers and see where they lead you.

And while you do that enjoy the games this summer, I know I will.

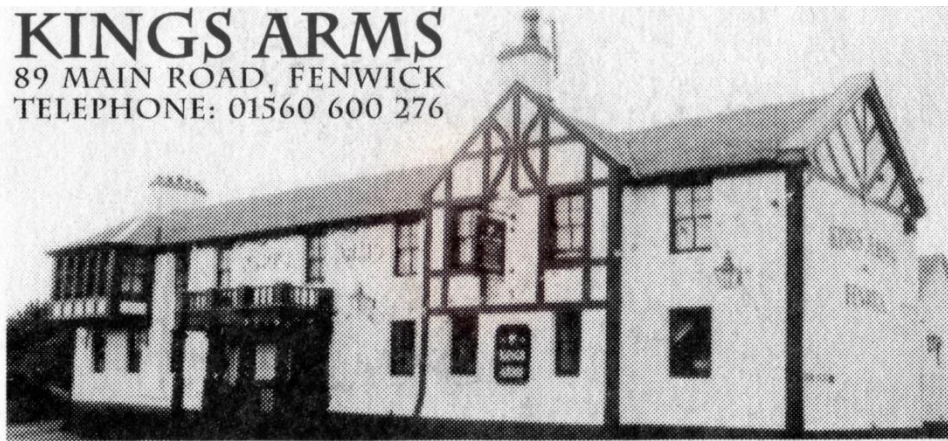

## Hall Development Update

Folk are asking questions such as, “when is it going ahead”, “Is it going ahead” and the like. We now have the tenders in for the proposed works and there is bad news and there is good news. First the bad news. The tenders for the full scheme of works were far greater than the pot of money we have available for the project. The good news is that along with the architects we have been able to indentify distinct phases to the project which will allow us to proceed as funds become available. The major works make up phase 1. This comprises a new entrance and foyer, upgraded toilets and the provision of the rear link to the Small Hall. We are still in discussions with the architect and the builder but we believe we can deliver Phase 1 with the funds we currently have available with a start date in June. There are a couple of “i’s” to dot and “t’s” to cross before we get there but we are very close. We are now looking at a start date of the 9<sup>th</sup> June though that may slip a little yet with a construction period lasting 10-12 weeks. These things will become definite in the next few days I would expect to have decisions in place soon after this issue of The Covenanter drops through your door.

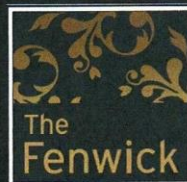
