And round we go again...

Yes, it is that time of year again. A time when nights sparkle with fairy lights and the days are crisp and frosty. A time when robins sit on fence posts and donkeys stare sweetly at glowing mangers. A time when families meet and greet and spend happy times together round roaring log fires. A time too when magic is in the air or so the Christmas cards would have us believe.

As December knocks on the door there is shopping to do, cards to post, presents to wrap, food to buy, drinks to buy, Christmas do's, work nights out, children's parties, neighbour's parties, family events, holiday travel, tree to buy, decorations to retrieve (usually from the loft), carol concerts, nativity plays, school services, church services, parcels to post, stocking to hang, Santa to feed, and more. When we have eaten, and partied and slumbered it's time to start over as the sales bite and that oversized, wrongly coloured, Christmas sweater Auntie bought has to be returned!

Is this really Christmas? A round of spending, doing and going! Is this what it is really about? Or is this what we have made it? Where did peace and goodwill disappear to? In the mad rush have we lost sight of the real excitement of the season? Have we lost sight of the love, joy and peace come down to us in the form of a vulnerable baby? In the gift giving and gift receiving have we lost sight of the real gift at the heart of Christmas? A gift not wrapped in gaudy paper and shiny bows and placed under the tree but a gift wrapped in swaddling clothes and placed in a manger. A gift that can't be found in the shops or online, a gift that money cannot buy, yet a gift so costly, so valuable that there is not a credit card in the world with enough credit to purchase it. A gift so precious that you might expect it to be limited to a very special few and yet this gift is for all men, all women and all children everywhere. This gift is for you - God's gift of Jesus is for you!

And what happened to Advent? That time of expectant waiting like a mother longing for her child to be born. A time of longing for the promise of the gift to be born in our midst and into our hearts. A time to contemplate the gift and the promise it brings. Isaiah announces the promise when he writes, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end" (Isaiah 12:6-7). Just look at those names "Wonderful", "Mighty", "Everlasting" and "Prince".

Is this the Jesus in the manger you see? This is the promise delivered for you. Love, joy, peace all wrapped in a tiny bundle yet full of the glory of God! An event and a person to have us standing wide eyed and open mouthed, gob smacked with awe just as the shepherds were filled with awe and wonder. An event to have us fall on our knees and worship just as the Magi fell on their knees and worshipped.

This is Christmas. The real present is the real presence of God in you and with you. "Happy holidays" just doesn't cut it. Even "Merry Christmas" is lame. As you prepare for this festive season, as you spend time rushing around the shops and partying with friends may you take a moment or more to catch your breath and contemplate the real Christmas behind the Christmas we have created. And in that moment may you catch just a glimpse of the fullness of the glory of God. Just a glimpse will take your breath away and leave in awe of the gift offered and presented to you each Christmas and throughout the year.

In the opening, in the unwrapping and in the receiving may God bless you, may God truly bless you.

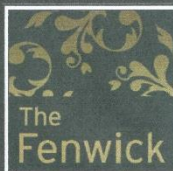

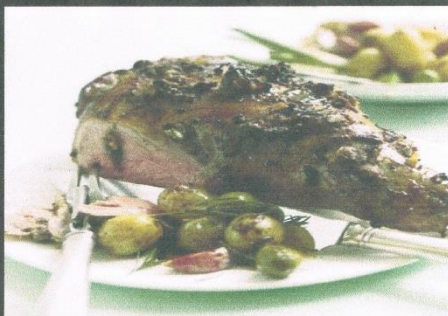
