Dear Friends,

I was fascinated by a news story that appeared in early April, which demonstrates how our harmful words may have negative consequences that we never imagined. James Stephens learned that lesson the hard way. Stephens was fired from his job as chief financial officer for the Georgia Subsequent Injury Trust Fund after his boss heard some less-than-flattering commentary Mike Coan, director of the fund and Stephens' supervisor, had a habit of calling after hours. After one such call, Stephens had a heated conversation with his wife about Coan, who was listening after Stephens accidentally called him back.

Consequently, Stephens is filing suit against his boss for eavesdropping and invasion of privacy. David Guldenschuh, the attorney representing both Stephens and his wife, claims that once Coan knew the conversation was intended to be private, he had a legal obligation to terminate the call, referring to the call as "voyeuristic eavesdropping" and "felonious conduct."

Rikki Klieman, legal analyst for CBS News, understands the rationale for the lawsuit, but sees a potential hurdle in its ability to proceed. "What we find here is someone who really believed he had a reasonable expectation of privacy in having a very, very confidential conversation with his wife and that yet, it may not be private at all."

That reminded me of Jesus' words in Matthew 12:34-37. "For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him. But I tell you that everyone will have to give account on the day of judgment for every careless word they have spoken. For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned."

I'm sure that we've all said things that we've regretted. I certainly have. There may well be things that we've said about other people that we'd be really embarrassed if they heard. However, whether they have heard what we've said or not, Jesus tells us that we will be held accountable for every careless word we have spoken.

How seriously do we take his words? Do we really believe that to be true? It should be a sober warning to each one of us. At one level I find it rather scary. The Apostle James also warns of the destructive power of the tongue. He says, "With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in God's likeness. Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be. Can both fresh water and salt water flow from the same spring? My brothers, can a fig-tree bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Neither can a salt spring produce fresh water,"

So, what can we do about it? Even if James Stephens wins his case, which I suspect is very unlikely, the damage has already been done. The relationship will never be the same. I wouldn't recommend trying to take out a legal case against God for listening in to your private conversations. However, the answer can be found in 1 John 1:8,9 where the Apostle writes: "If we claim to be without sin we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." Hopefully none of us will get into the same kind of mess as James Stephens, but hopefully we can learn from his experience. May we seek God's forgiveness for our mistakes in the past, and allow him to purify our hearts so that we learn not to say things that we later regret, that we might build others up rather than tear them down

## 5 Significant Attitude Differences That Separate Growing And Declining Churches

So what's the difference between a growing church and a declining church?

Well there are many, but one of the biggest differences I see is the attitude of the leaders.

The leaders of growing churches almost always share a common attitude. So do the leaders of declining churches.

And the attitude has a huge influence over the *results* each church sees.

Attitude may or may not be everything, but it's close.

Here are 5 attitude differences I see again and again in growing churches and declining churches.

### **1. We Can V. We Can't**

Perhaps the biggest differences I see between growing churches and declining churches is the attitude around what's possible.

Growing churches believe they can.

Declining churches believe they can't.

They're both right.

One of my all time favourite quotes is Henry Ford's "Whether you believe you can or believe you can't, you're right." He's correct.

Growing churches make a way when there's no way, which seems to be what God specializes in if you read the Bible.

When you sit around your leadership table, do you come up with 20 ways to make it happen, or 20 reasons why it won't work? That tells you far more about your church than you probably want it to.

Growing churches believe they can. It's that simple. And even if they're wrong, at least they tried. The mission is important enough to take significant risk.

## **2. Them V. Us**

Declining churches focus on themselves.

Growing churches focus on the people they're trying to reach.

If your leadership table conversations are all about the needs and wants of your members, it's a sign that your church is insider focused.

The mission of the church is to reach the world. Growing churches not only *know* that; they live it.

Besides, who likes to hang out with selfish people?

And ironically, selfish people almost always end up in a very surprising place: alone. Because a life devoted to self ultimately leaves you alone.

That's also true for selfish churches.

If you're becoming smaller and smaller, is it because you're selfish?

## **3. Principles V. Preferences**

Declining churches focus on their member's preferences.

*Todd didn't like the music. Allison thinks we're not deep enough. Bill wants to start a new program.*

And so the leaders respond, trying to please everybody.

In reality, declining churches bend to the preferences of its members.

Growing churches don't.

Instead, they focus on the principles (even strategies) that will help them reach new people.

Is your leadership team principle driven or preference driven? There's a world of difference between the two.

## **4. Proactive V. Reactive**

This is a close cousin of points 2 and 3 above, but the difference is deadly or life-giving depending on where you land.

Growing churches are *proactive*. They choose their agenda and immediately get on issues that can impact their future.

Declining churches are reactive, letting members determine the agenda and reacting to problems as they arise.

In fact, most declining churches are so busy reacting to problems other people raise that they never get around to charting a course for the future.

If you never get around to charting a course for the future, you will have no future.

Growing churches have a strong bias for setting their *own* agendas, not in the selfish sense, but in a way that determined leaders see what the mission requires and decide to deal with it.

The leaders in a growing church simply refuse to yield to the agenda of others that would take them off mission.

And as a result, they are far more effective.

## **5. Now V. Eventually**

Growing churches act. And they act now.

Declining churches don't.

Declining churches don't actually *say* they won't act, they'll just say they'll get to it 'eventually', or someday, or 'when the time is right'—which means never.

By contrast, as I outlined [here](#), great leaders and great teams banish the word 'someday' and [other words](#) from their vocabulary.

If you want to be effective, you act.

If you want to be ineffective, you don't.

Talk without action has little value. And too many church leaders specialize in talk.

In addition, too many church teams meet for the sake of meeting.

If you can't remember the last time you made a major decision that changed the course of your church, your leaders are wasting their time.

If you talk about the same issues meeting after meeting with no resolution, you're spinning your wheels.

Does that mean you have to act on everything? Well, yes and no.

If you're not going to act, strike the item off the agenda and move on.

If you are going to act, act. Now.

Just make a decision and move on with it. Don't get stuck in the no man's land of believing the lie that talking about things solves things.

As my friend Casey Graham says, action produces traction. So act.



## FENWICK COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Fenwick Community Council met on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> May. Cllr.McFadzean, Cllr. Freel and three members of the public were in attendance.

Due to a diary error, Louise Hughes our new Community Worker was not at the meeting. Louise is keen to get involved with any local groups or individuals who can benefit from her support. The Police reported one incident of fraud - the use of a bank card to fraudulently withdraw monies from ATMs. The enquiry continues.

We have now received confirmation that the Pharmacy Hearing will be held on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> May. In order to constitute a Pharmacy Practices Committee, Ayrshire and Arran Health Board have had to “borrow” Pharmacy Practices Committee Members from other Health Boards. Irene Wilson and Jean Brown will represent Fenwick and Moscow and Waterside Community Councils at the Hearing.

Representatives of the Community Council met with Nick Kelly, Outdoor Services on 15<sup>th</sup> May. The possibility of having the play park fence moved back to its original position to maximise the enclosed space available for safe play was discussed. This will be subject to funding and the Community Council will pursue this with East Ayrshire. As requested at the meeting, the litter bins in the KGV Playing Field have now been moved to more useful locations. Litter is still an issue on the roads around the village, but we believe that the new signs on the slip roads have had some impact on the volume of litter being discarded. The waste deposited in front of the field gates on Stewarton Road was attracting further littering and Nick has since had this removed. The debris from the ditch cleaning on Clunch Road has also been removed and the litter cleared.

We will be hosting a Dogs Trust Roadshow on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> September with free microchipping, nail clipping and dog health assessments available from the Dogs Trust Veterinary Nurse. More details to follow nearer the time.

Please join us on our next litter picks to clean up our village in advance of Gala Day. These will be held on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June at 10am and Monday 4<sup>th</sup> June at 7pm, meet at the John Fulton Hall.

Our next meeting is Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> June at 7.30pm in Fenwick Primary School. Kerr Chalmers, Ayrshire Roads Alliance has been invited to attend but has not yet confirmed his attendance. We will post an update on Friends of Fenwick in advance of the meeting.
