*Dear Friends,*

This has been rather an eventful summer for our family. I enjoyed having folk from both congregations and a few others who came to the Open House at the Manse to celebrate me getting my bus pass. I was overwhelmed by your generosity and was able to donate £285 to the work of Tearfund. A big thank you to everyone who contributed.

We had a family holiday in Northern Ireland, spending a few days in Belfast where we visited the Titanic Experience and a few days in Port Stewart on the north coast. We had some time at home when among other things we climbed Ben Lomond and were tourist in Glasgow.

However, the big excitement of the summer was Anna's engagement to Matthew Gill. The wedding is planned for 3<sup>rd</sup> August next year with the service at Riccarton and the reception in the Hall at Fenwick.

Laura and I are delighted as we have got to know and love Matthew over the past 3 years. Again the response from both congregations has been tremendous as you have shared in our celebrations.

As I reflect on these, and also the support that I received earlier this year at the time of my mother's death, I am reminded of Paul's words to the Christians in Rome as he moves towards the conclusion of his letter. "Be devoted to one another in brotherly love... Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. Live in harmony with one another..." That's just a part of his practical instruction on how to live out the Christian life. (Rom 12:9-21) We are not meant to live as isolated individuals. It is God's intention that we are bound together in his love as his family.

Some time ago I was visiting one of the Riccarton members in a Care Home. One of the elders came in while I was there, and during the conversation this lady said to her, "I don't call him 'my minister', I just call him 'Colin', because he's my friend." That meant so much to me, but I think it also sums up so much of what church is supposed to be about. We are there for each other, to be there for each other in the good times and the bad, to "rejoice with those who rejoice" and to "mourn with those who mourn".

I take encouragement from the blessings that I have received from being part of the church. I am thankful that we do see so much of Paul's teaching in this passage worked out in Fenwick. I know that there is always room for improvement, but let's appreciate what we already have, and use that as a base to build from that we can continue to grow together as the family of God. May God bless each of you as you seek to do that.

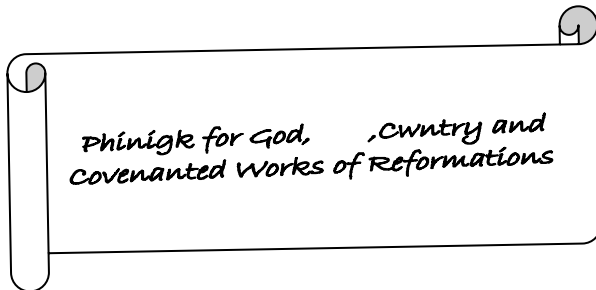
