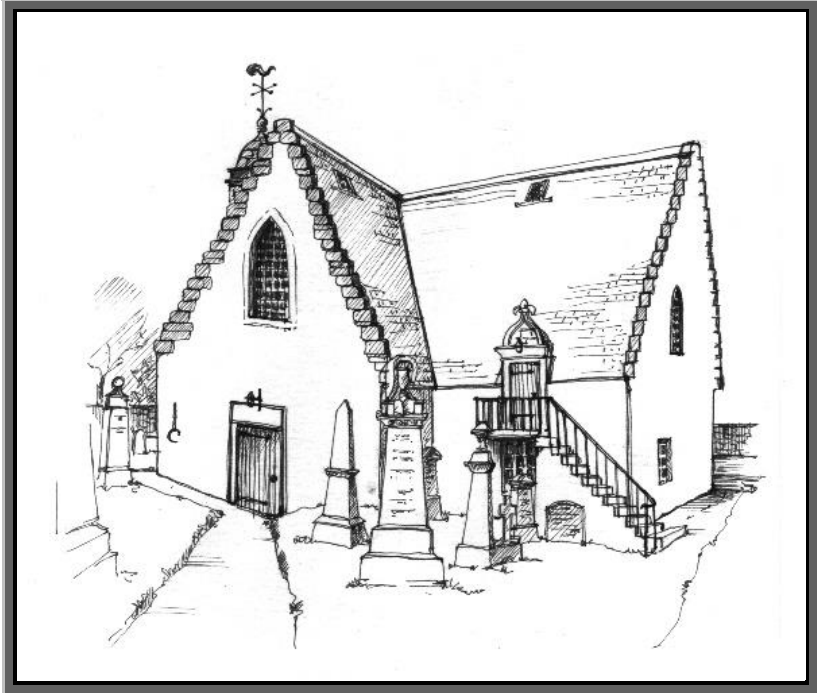

Dear Friends

It is not yet Easter, but it is the season of Eastertide, of Lent, Mothering Sunday and Holy Week and while these are times of reflection, discipleship, celebrations and remembrance, we are assured that the promise and wonder of Easter Sunday never diminishes. We stand amazed together with Mary Magdalene and the women who came prepare the crucified body of their Lord Jesus Christ for final burial, and hear again these words from the angels, words which are so profound for all of humanity, ‘He is risen, he is not here, remember he told you about this’. And they remembered, rushing back to tell the disciples who, even though they too had heard Jesus’ assurances about His resurrection, did not believe the women that morning.

So we remember all the words of scripture which tell us of the resurrection promise, we think and reflect and consider, perhaps in one of the many Lent Study opportunities in Fenwick, in Kilmarnock and on-line. You can visit the websites of our national Church of Scotland , Christian Aid, the Scottish Bible Society or one of the apps on your smart phone or tablet such as Digital Parish or Sanctuary First. This is a good time to think again, to search for the road home to the Kingdom and to ‘Walk Humbly with God’ our theme and focus for Lent 2022. It is the word and way of Christ growing in us that releases us from only walking in the ways of the world, and it brings blessings to those around us and peace to our own hearts.

We are planning a series of three **Lenten Studies**, running on **Wednesday evenings** from **23rd March to 6th April at 7.15pm**. These will be hosted by Alastair and Anne Naismith at Weaver’s Court and although it is a series of three, each is an independent event, and you are welcome to attend any one or more of the evenings. Please let Anne or Alastair know if you plan to be there The series is entitled “**There is a green hill**” and is based on the well-known Cecil Alexander hymn of the same title. It is designed to give participants an opportunity, in an informal setting, to consider the events leading up to the death and resurrection of Jesus, and the implications for each one of us.

Further information can be had from Alastair Naismith.

There will be a Maundy Thursday Communion Service in the church at 7.30pm on 14th April.

New Laigh Kirk in Kilmarnock town centre will host a Friday vigil on the 15th April between midday and 3pm, this will be six short reflections and there is time to come and go between each one.

On Easter Day, the 17th April there will be a Sunday Sunrise service and egg rolling for all at 8.30am in the sports field and an Easter Celebration Service at 10.30am in the church.

We have all been appalled and horrified by the events unfolding in Ukraine and the sight of millions of displaced people, mostly women and children fleeing from the devastation of a war which we never thought to see happening in Europe. We are not helpless in this and we can reach out with what we have, including faith and prayer to offer some comfort and safety to these people. During April, we welcome the Moderator of the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland, Rt Hon Lord Wallace of Tankerness to this presbytery and although he won't be visiting Fenwick Parish Church formally, there will be a programme of events and local visits arranged and opportunities for him to meet presbyters and others in the community. One of the moderator's chaplains is Rev Fraser Macnaughton who was a previous minister here in Fenwick.

I wish you all many blessings at this Easter tide and may you know, with a strong assurance that the Lord is risen indeed and reigns in glory and in our hearts, today and always. Come and find His kingdom, in the street, in the church, on the digital screen and in our hearts.

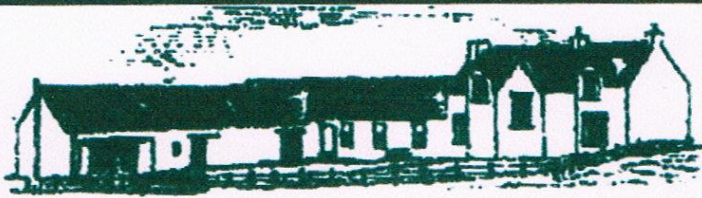

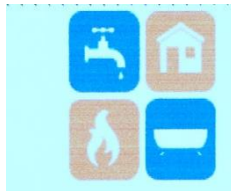

Who gave his only Son that we might have life:

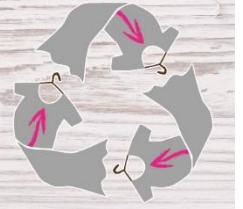

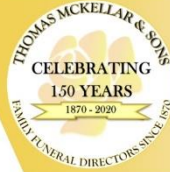

Fenwick Bowling Club

The club opens for its 96th season on Saturday April 23rd. Since the formation of the club in 1927, it has been available as a facility for the residents of Fenwick and the surrounding area. Sadly, like virtually every other bowling club in Scotland, membership numbers have declined in the recent years. Several local clubs have closed including the oldest bowling club in Scotland, Kilmarnock Bowling Club, established 281 years ago which closed last year due to lack of members.

We want to ensure that Fenwick Bowling Club remains a fixture in the village for many years to come and we have therefore joined Bowls Scotland's Try Bowls campaign to encourage people to come to the club and give it try. In addition, a regional Youth Development Officer has been appointed to encourage children to make use of the facility also.

So why try bowling:

- **Playing bowls is very doable.** Whatever your physique, bowls is a sport for everybody and it will help improve your fitness levels and mental wellbeing. So whether you are 9 or 99, it can be a game for you.
- **Bowls is not expensive.** To get going you don't need lots of new kit. A pair of flat-soled shoes is all you will require.
- **Compared to most sports, age and gender differences have less of an effect on a game of bowls,** so it's a perfect sport to spend time and enjoy a bit of friendly competition with your family.
- **Bowls clubs are sociable places full of people looking to have fun,** so bowls is a great way to relax, make new friends and feel part of your local community.

As a further encouragement, we are offering **free club membership for 2022** to any new member who wants to have a go at bowls for the first time.

All that will be required is a pair of flat-soled shoes. Bowls and other equipment will be supplied, and coaching will be available.

Our clubhouse can seat around 50 people and has ample parking facilities and is available for hire for meetings etc. on request.

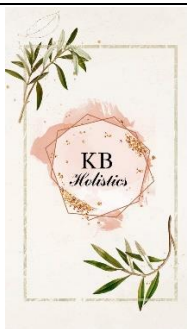

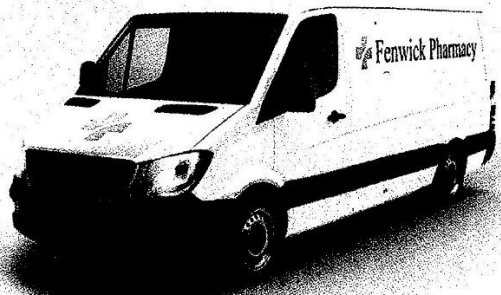
