New beginnings...

Summer is almost over (what there is of it) and folk are talking of autumn. The nights will soon draw in and the leaves will fall from the trees and before we know it the winter months will be upon us. While spring is seen as the season of new life autumn is the season of dying back. A season to prepare for the dormancy that winter brings.

That said what I really want to talk about is fresh starts and new beginnings for this season too (or perhaps more correctly the crossover period between summer and autumn) is a time of fresh starts. There has recently been a flurry of pictures on Facebook of first day at school and first day at new school photographs. Last year's nursery children have graduated to P1 in Primary School. Last year's P7s have gone onto the big school to continue their education in secondary and to start to shape a future for themselves as they settle into subjects.

Soon a new round of fresh starts will commence as our young adults go on to start college and university courses. The latter perhaps that little bit scarier for parents as youngsters start to fledge their wings and head off to places further from home.

All these starts are an opportunity firstly to shape opportunities for the future and secondly to gain new friends. For students heading away from home the new beginning in Halls of Residence or sharing a flat with friends is the beginning of independent living and a shaping of their adult lives to come.

It is not just education where fresh starts occur. The church's official year runs from Advent (end of November) back round to Advent. In preaching and teaching teams that makes sense. The year begins with the promise of the coming King and his birth on earth it works around to Easter and Christ's giving of himself for us on the cross and his promise of resurrection life. From there it is Pentecost and the gift of the Holy Spirit. We then live in the gift of the Spirit for the rest of the year. Of course there is also a celebration of God's abundance with Harvest and the opportunity to remember the sacrifice of others with Remembrance Sunday. And that is the church's year.

The church's unofficial year is quite different though. While the natural world hibernates though the winter months the church shuts down for the summer. It is not quite a full shut down but generally most activities either slow down or stop for the summer. And the church comes out of hibernation now, just as the schools go back and the students head away from home the church begins to gear up its activity and it is full steam ahead towards Christmas and the rest of the year.

Now is the time of new beginnings and time of fresh starts. If you ever thought about coming along to Church or bringing your children to Junior Church now is the time to make that step. It is more than church on Sunday through various groups to start... and it is not all religion (I wouldn't even say church itself is about religion but that is perhaps a subject to address at another time). Photography workshops have met over the summer but they make a fresh start as they move to a pattern of Saturday mornings and Thursday evenings. The craft cafe makes a new start with a new craft project and the book group start up again. There is also The Guild, Garden Club and more.

But thinking about fresh starts what about those questions of faith and about faith that you have? The Alpha Course makes a return for its autumn run. To call it a course is something of a misnomer it is more of an exploration of faith issues. There is a loose syllabus to stimulate thought and discussion but at its heart Alpha is about you bringing your questions. So whether it is just a desire to know what it is all about, or a chance to make comparisons with other faiths make a point of coming along to the Alpha supper later in the month.

One final thought. God is a God of new beginnings and fresh starts. It is never too late to make that beginning of walking in faith with God and it is never too late to return to the faith that you left behind in your youth or at some other point in your life. Remember I said church is not about religion... at its heart the Christian faith is about walking in relationship with a God who loves. A God who loves you so much that he gave his life for you. It is that sacrifice of Christ upon the cross that makes a fresh start (or a restart) with God possible. It is what we are about Sunday to Sunday and during the week to. Sometimes the trappings of religion help and sometimes they get in the way, but remember this it is not about this way or that way, it is about God who loves you with an unconditional love and desires that you walk in faith with him. The invitation is God's to start out and walk hand in hand with him.

So think about it! With all the children making their fresh starts and new beginnings is it time for you to make yours?






