## **Jungle Drums...**

So no doubt the jungle drums have been beating and most of you will have heard that I am moving on from Fenwick. Just in case you haven't heard, yes the rumours are true, it is time to take up a fresh challenge and journey with some new folk in faith. Dates are yet to be finalised but we are likely to move mid October through to Montrose for myself to become minister of Montrose South and Ferryden Parish Church. There will be some difficult partings to come and the leaving will not be easy. We both felt that the time was right to make the move and the folk in Montrose have been quite welcoming.

**“What does this mean for Fenwick?”** is perhaps the question I have been asked most since I first announced the move.

In essence it is business as normal. Behind the scenes there will be some changes but the Church doesn't stop just because there is no full time minister in post.

Initially the Presbytery will appoint an Interim Moderator to take care of the business arrangements. There may also be a locum appointed to take care of Sunday services and the pastoral work. Any locum will be a part-time arrangement and not full time. With those arrangement in place and the ongoing service of members the church will continue to function.

That's the short term! Longer term the Presbytery Plan is a linkage with Riccarton Parish Church. Every Presbytery (church administrative area, in this case Irvine & Kilmarnock) has a cap on the number of ministers it can deploy and has to plan to reduce to that number. It is by and large determined by the number of ministers that the Church nationally can afford to employ and more recently by a shortage of ministers. The criteria for determining whether a congregation is to be readjusted are largely based on the perceived workload of the minister which in turn is based on the the population of the parish. The missional outlook and activity of a congregation is also supposed to bear some weight. That said, Fenwick with a parish population of under 2000 was always going to be a candidate for readjustment. So the Presbytery Plan calls for a linkage at the first vacancy. I should note that the same Presbytery Plan notes that the church buildings in Fenwick are essential as a place of worship and community service. There are no plans to close Fenwick Parish Church now or in the near future.

Linkage is not a union of 2 or more churches! Linkage simply means that 2 congregations share a minister. Finances, Kirk Sessions and identities remain separate. There are linkages where the congregations join together to share resources and there are linkages where the congregations involved have little or nothing to do with each other. Linkages can also be severed in the future.

**Why Riccarton Parish Church some have asked?** I have to confess I have asked the same question. Geographically it is not the obvious choice. When neighbouring parishes are ruled out due to population density you are left with possible linkages with Kilmaurs or one of the two Stewarton Churches. But it is not as simple as that. The Presbytery Plan calls for the 2 Stewarton Churches to be linked together (at first vacancy) and for Kilmaurs to be linked with Crosshouse. As the planning process progressed the team charged with the task were left with Fenwick and Riccarton within the Kilmarnock area looking for partners. The 3 other town centre churches have all become unions within recent history increasing their parish size and hence population.

So geographically it looks a bit odd. Two churches on opposing sides of the town. Remember though it is only the minister who has to make that journey not the members of the congregation. That said the 2 congregations probably share a similar ethos and outlook and hence Rev Colin Strong would fit well with the current ethos in Fenwick.

**So when will this happen?** It might not! First Colin Strong is asked if he will accept the linkage. He may say no he may say yes. If he says yes both congregations have to vote for the linkage and then vote for Colin Strong as the minister of the linkage. If all say yes then a service of linkage is arranged and Colin Strong is inducted to the linked charge. If Colin says no or the vote goes against linkage then the options for Fenwick are very limited indeed and may be restricted to coming under the continued guardianship of Presbytery.

**So is this the beginning of the end for Fenwick Parish Church?** Short answer NO! There are folk who have suggested that it is downhill from here and some have even said they will leave if it is a linkage. I have been minister of Fenwick Parish Church for a little over 16 years and I believe my message to the folk of the Kirk and the folk of Fenwick has not changed in that time. If you want to see a Church in Fenwick get involved! That means coming along on Sunday and joining in and that means rolling up your sleeves and getting stuck in with the work and mission of the Kirk! I have always believed that within the Kirk there are the people and the necessary talents and spiritual gifts to maintain and grow the Church. Everybody has something to give in order that the work of the Church proceeds and multiplies. The problem is folk often don't see it that way. Church is about what we take out and not what we put in one way of looking at it. The bottom line is the Church in Fenwick will only grow if folk support it by getting involved. If you have any inkling of exploring faith issues or any inkling that a church in the village is a good idea then get along and get involved.

I get busy lives and the charging around after children. I get that other things get in the way... Sunday is the day for sport or shopping or socialising or whatever. It is a question of priorities and all I can really say is if you think a church in Fenwick is of any import get along and get involved.

I also understand that some people simply have no interest in faith issues. To you its a load of nonsense or an outdated concept. I would have loved to have had a conversation with you about belief and a loving God but that is unlikely to happen now. What I will say is this. Don't stand on the sidelines and complain when Fenwick Kirk closes its doors for the last time.

I understand too the folk who have turned their back on the Kirk (sometimes God too) because of the attitude or actions of a member or members of the Kirk. Yes we have not always been the best advertisement for a faith that is based on the love and compassion of God. All I can say is this Fenwick Kirk is in a better place that it was. Folk who have dropped in of late have commented on the warm welcoming and friendly atmosphere that they have encountered. So perhaps its time to give the Kirk a second chance.

The Kirk will slowly slip into decline if folk sit on the sidelines, either in the Kirk or looking in from outside. It will slip into the decline if the attitude is "Well that is it!". That decline is reversible, always has been, it just needs the good will of all of the people.

Isn due course it will be bon voyage from me, but I do not believe that whatever the outcome of Presbytery Plans are that it is goodbye Fenwick Kirk. As some would say the Future is in your hands!

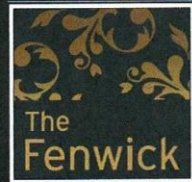

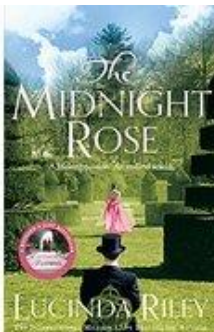
