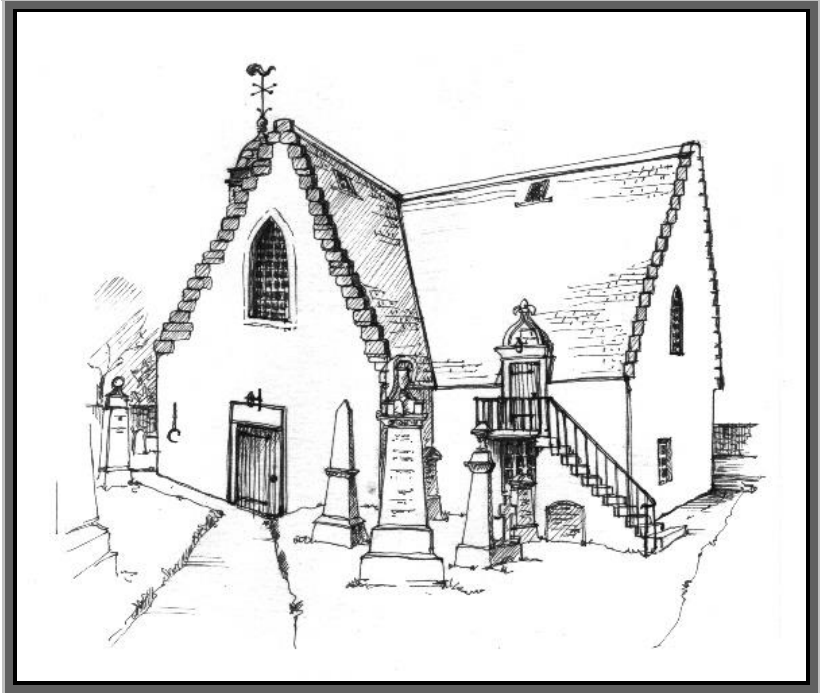

Dear Friends

Alistair suggested to me that I should call this a postcard from Callander and tell you about our short but lovely few days holiday there and the cycling we managed to do. Like so many people who are fortunate enough to have a holiday, we felt the benefit of the change of air and scenery and we enjoyed the more relaxed pace of life, even if we were cycling for some of it.

In my service and sermon preparations over these recent weeks and as found in last month's Covenanter, I've been reading and reflecting on the things which sustain our faith and so, in turn, sustain the life of the church. Some of these are formal and some less so and without dwelling too much on the subject of holidays, I have to tell you that my faith was sustained in part by the scenery around us last week. The sunshine, the new leaves unfurling on the many oak trees for which the Trossachs is famous, the green-ness of the grass and new bracken and perhaps most of all, the carpets of glorious Scottish bluebells with their vivid colour and lovely scent, these all lifted our spirits, filling our hearts with gladness and thankfulness. Part of this sense of our faith being sustained is the wonder of renewal and being restored. In reading the words of scripture, and singing the metrical twenty third psalm, we remember again the declaration of the psalmist, the Lord leads me by still waters and lets me rest in green pastures, he restores my soul.

In our parish, stretching up across the green fields to the moor and out over the woodlands towards the town and right into our gardens we can find that sense of renewal around us each day when we ask the Lord to see his gift of continual creation all around us.

On the Monday after the Coronation of King Charles, some of the families in the congregation did the 'Big Help Out' and in keeping with King Charles' lively interest in nature, we built a Coronation Bug Hotel. The children brought bags of twigs and sticks, moss, leaves and stones, the grown ups brought wood, slates and tools, everyone brought enthusiasm and very quickly the hotel took shape. It is a work in progress and there is still room on each of the floors for more sticks and stones so please feel free to add more to the hotel which you can find between the hedge and the hall door. Just as we finished the building, a very long and wriggly worm came out of the grass and wriggled into the hotel, much to the delight of all the children and grown up builders. I'm sure there will be many more residents by now.

Our faith is also sustained by our sense of community and so we look forward to the many community events which are coming up over the summer months, the different events of the Gala Week in June, the Fenwick Show in July, Family Faith events and our annual Songs of Praise Service in the church and in the

Fellowship of Kilmarnock Churches, and we are a part of this, there are mission and praise events which can also sustain and grow our faith. You can find information about these on the hall noticeboard and here in Covenanter.

As this is written, the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland is taking place in Edinburgh. This is another event which sustains our faith as we remember that we are part of the national church. We may question how things are done in these difficult times but it is good to remember that sense of belonging, the sense of where we have come from over each generation, the different ways we can and do contribute to national church life as well as local church life and our shared faith, praise, love and service to one another as we strive to live our lives as the Lord wants so that we are a blessing to one another and delight in his love for us.

Together, this summer, whatever we are doing, wherever we happen to be, apart or together, at home or on holiday, may you all know that sense of restoring and renewal and the enjoyment of easier days.

May the Lord bless you and keep you.
