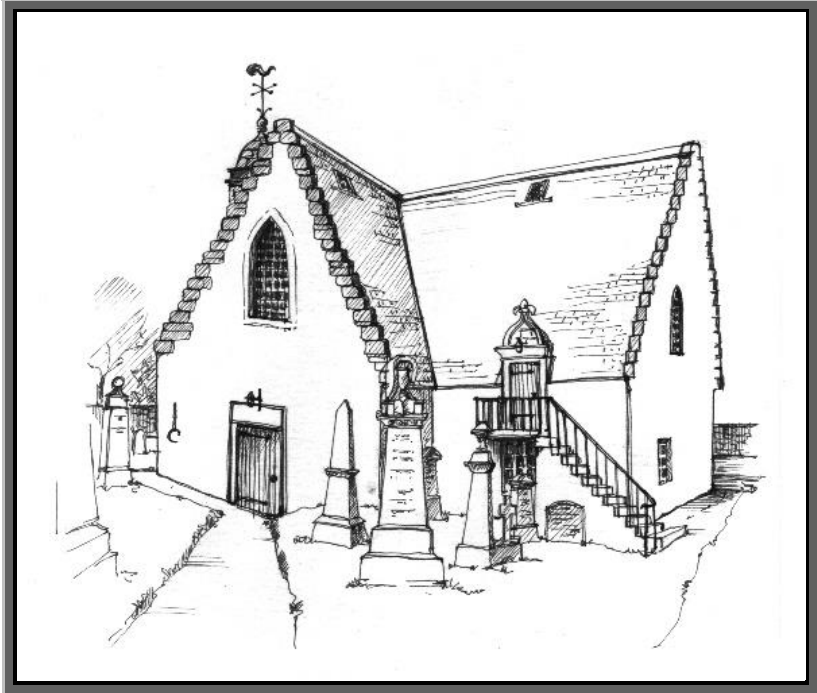

Dear Friends

The Grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you all.

Can you imagine driving into a town or even a village and there are no street or road signs, no obvious ways to find the place you are wanting to be, nothing to indicate the presence of shops, restaurants, hotels, homes or schools. While you may be bewildered at first, the bewilderment would soon become irritation and eventually you may have a sense of an uncaring and neglected place.

Can you imagine driving into a town or even a village where there is no church building, or at best an empty church and empty noticeboard, a building surrounded by a graveyard and gates that are shut. Sadly, this is a reality for communities the length and breadth of Scotland. Places where there are no signposts to God, no indication that there is a spiritual centre for the community to gather together and be there for the milestone moments in family life.

Here in the parish of Fenwick, there is a church building, and there is a hall complex, buildings which provide for all in the community, a place of busy noticeboards and car park, community activities, warm welcomes, worship and witness. A place for people of all ages. The church building may be in Fenwick but its activities and welcome encompass all the parish and every person within its bounds is prayed for on a daily basis, every person is cared for. You may not be known to the congregation but you are known to God and included in the prayers for the people of the parish and community.

That is what the national church is about. It has been, thus far, what is considered a territorial ministry, every part of Scotland is part of a parish, so every person has the church and the worshipping community, the congregation there for you. The landscape is changing now and there are too many places where the congregation can no longer sustain the building and the national church can no longer offer every congregation a full time minister as it was in the past.

Imagine our church buildings in our parish, well, you don't need to because you can find us easily. The notice on Main Road which points to where the church is could do with a bit of a clean up, it's true, but it still points in the right direction.

The notice boards point to events and activities in Fenwick and in the Kilmarnock churches for Fenwick Parish Church is part of the 'Fellowship of Kilmarnock Churches' not only the Church of Scotland but the Catholic churches, the Salvation Army, the Scottish Episcopal Church of Holy Trinity and others. We are glad to worship God together.

The hall lights are on most evenings, for meetings and for activities. The car park can be busy with cars or with the Strollers doing their stretching. The church gates are always open, the clock chimes and the bell rings.

The church building is the spiritual road sign and points the way to God. In its own way and especially through the activity of the congregation, the church is the building which tells the community that God is here, in our midst, a dependable, faithful and steadfast God. The building by its very being, is an inher 4itance of stone and wood, build by the saints who came before us and cared for by many generations of families who came after them. The building sustains our faith, provides spiritual shelter from the storms of life, gives us a place to gather in joy and in grief, on special days and ordinary days. It is a place for all of us who place our trust and hope in God, those of us who have many questions, those of us who were here last Sunday, those of us who haven't been here for a while. All are welcome.

While the building sustains our faith, the many activities of care, friendship, shared interests, worship and mission is what sustains the building. Even with Facebook, website and a livestream on-line presence, it is still the church building which sustains us and us which sustain the building. In our prayers for the people of whole parish and beyond, we pray in the words of Bernadette Farrell;

*Make us your building, sheltering others  
Walls made of living stone  
Many the gifts, many the people  
Many the hearts that yearn to belong  
Let us be servants to one another  
Making your kingdom come.*

May God bless you and keep you.
